

Census Golf Outing
At
Waverly Woods Golf Club, Marriottsville, Md

Date/Time: Monday August 25, 1:00 shotgun (be there by 12:30)

Directions: From Census (approximate drive time – 1 hour):
Take the beltway to the Baltimore/Washington Parkway
Take the BALT/WASH PKWY NORTH exit, EXIT 22A, toward BALTIMORE.
Merge onto MD-100 W toward ELLICOTT CITY. 8.2 mi
Merge onto US-29 N/COLUMBIA PIKE toward I-70. 3.4 mi
Merge onto I-70 W via EXIT 25B toward FREDERICK. 4.1 mi
Take the MARRIOTTSVILLE ROAD exit, EXIT 83. 0.2 mi
Take the MARRIOTTSVILLE ROAD NORTH ramp. 0.1 mi
Merge onto MARRIOTTSVILLE RD. 0.3 mi
Turn RIGHT onto WARWICK WAY.

Format: 4 person medley (3 bb on par 3, 2 bb on par 4, 1 bb on par 5)

Closest to the hole on all par 3's	ball must be on green
Long Drive Women - #11	ball must be in #11 fairway
Long Drive Men - #9	ball must be in #9 fairway
50/50 Hole - #5	ball must be on green

Tournament Rules:

1. Note on the scorecard which tees you played.
2. Record *gross* score for all golfers. *The handicap committee will adjust all scores and post them in the GolfNet system.*
3. To expedite play:
 - Max of 10 strokes on a hole. If you get to 10 strokes on a hole, pick up and move on.
 - Treat all wooded areas as a lateral hazard (most of them are marked as such, i.e. red stakes).
 - For a lost ball or a ball deemed out of bounds, drop a ball in the area where the ball was lost with a one-stroke penalty.
 - Limit looking for a lost ball to under three minutes.
4. Turn in scorecards to Joe Keehan/Susan Keehan.

Play “ready golf”...

In general:

Keep up with the group in front of you, don't worry about the group behind you.

For Census outings if you think a ball may be lost or out of bounds do not hit a provisional ball, go to the spot where the ball was headed, drop a ball, and take a one shot penalty.

On the tee

Be **ready to hit** when it's your turn.

Watch all shots in your foursome closely.

In the fairway

Be **ready to hit** as soon as the group in front of you clears.

Take enough clubs to your ball to cover all possible scenarios. DO NOT walk out to the ball to evaluate the shot then go back to the cart for the club.

Find and hit your ball before assisting in the search for a partner's lost ball. Allow **3 minutes** to search for the ball. If a ball is lost do NOT go back and hit from the previous spot. Drop a ball at a point where the ball was believed to be lost with a one-stroke penalty.

As a foursome, be sure that both carts progress with the group. DO NOT get in a situation where one cart is left far behind and has to be retrieved.

On the green

Line up your putt as others are putting and be **ready to putt** when it's your turn.

Putt out and avoid marking an 18-inch putt.

Place any additional clubs in line with the hole and the cart for quick retrieval when finished putting.

Tally the score on the next tee.
